## **School Stream App - Please download the latest Version 2.0 and create an App account**

School Stream App is our communication tool between Donovan Primary and our caregivers, families and friends. The App is evolving all the time and School Stream has been very proactive at implementing new ideas to improve the App as they get feedback from their users. Some things to note are:

1. The latest update has allowed us to create a more individualised menu list. For example you will now see the 'sports' folder has been split into individuals sports. This will keep all notices for a particular sport in its own folder, making it easier for you all to find what you are looking for.
2. The icon on the bottom left of the screen with 4 small black squares with the words 'latest' underneath is the best place to see what has been sent most recently. It is in chronological order with the most recently sent item at the top. It is worth noting that this screen works similar to your email inbox. You can manage items for your own needs. It is a great idea to delete items you no longer need. Any item(s) deleted in your 'latest' screen will still appear in its relevant folder under the main menu. To delete an item simply swipe left and press delete.
3. Remember to register your account. To do this go to the main menu and tap three bars at top left, go to account, and set up email and phone number. The advantage of this feature will be that in the future we can contact individuals or groups with messages specific to them only.

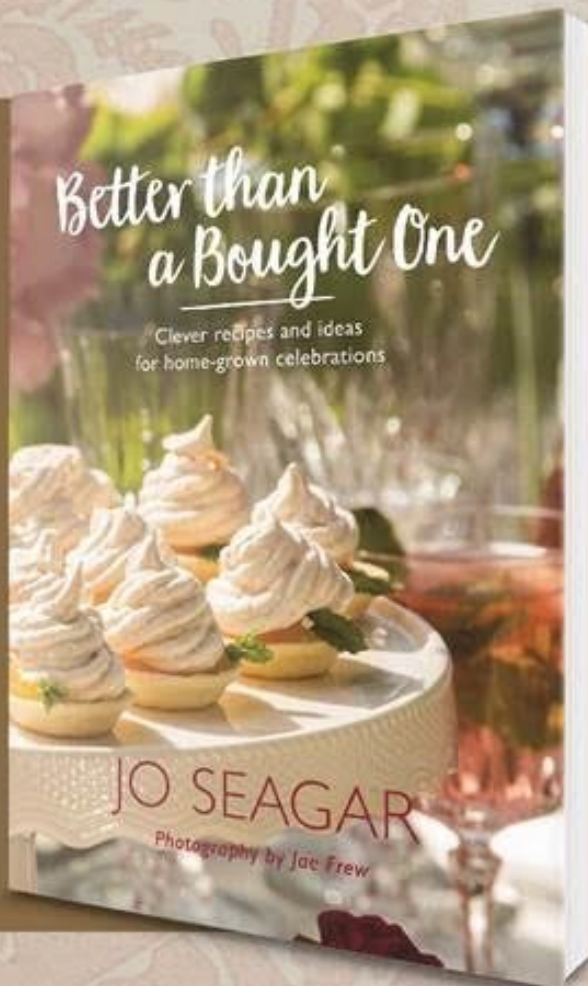
