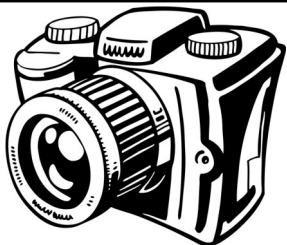

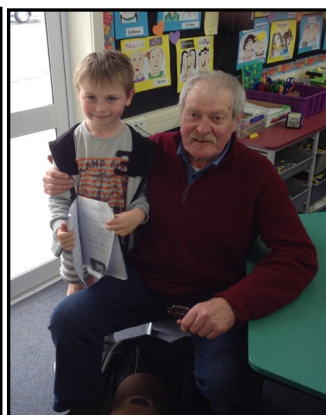
Seniors School Camp:

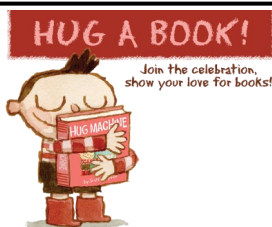


Junior Syndicate Grandparents Day.

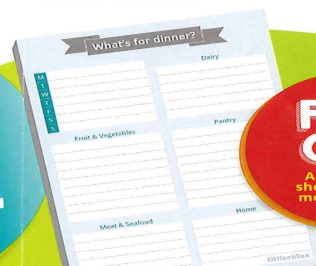
