Swimming: Reminder that swimming will be starting the first week back in term 2 for our Middle and Senior students. Look at the calendar on the left hand side of the first page of this newsletter for the dates. The Seniors will be leaving from Donovan Primary by bus, at 8.50am and it will not wait if you are late. They will be swimming between 9am-10.30am. The middle syndicate will be bused to Splash Palace at about 10.10am to swim between 10.30am-12noon. They will be returned to school just after 12noon. There are a couple of things that you could do at home that would assist in the changing rooms. Make sure your children know what they are wearing to school, name their clothing and ensure that your child can easily tie up their hair. Swimming caps are available for purchase at the pool. We also recommend children have named swimming goggles. Due to the changing areas being public domain, we will need male assistance in the changing rooms if anyone is available. Like all school based activities we do rely on parental help, so if you are able to assist can you please complete the swimming helpers form that is on Schoolstream.

Please let the school know of any changes in addresses, phone numbers, emails or work details. You can either email, phone or send through the 'contact us' form on School Stream. **School Stream.** Don't forget to check to see if you have the latest version of Schoolstream. If you wish to check, then open up the programme, select the three horizontal bars in the top left corner of Schoolstream and down at the bottom of the screen it should show version 2.1.115 (Android) or 2.1.41 (Apple). If you do not have this latest version then you can either do an update or uninstall and reinstall to get the latest version. To do an update on androids, go to the Play Store and type School Stream in the search bar. The app and the update will show. Select the update and it should download for you. It worked for me, so see how you go. If all else fails, uninstall and reinstall.


