#### **SWIMMING:**

**Junior Swimming** -Rooms 18,17,16,15,14,13 and 12 will begin their swimming programme on Tuesday 22 June. They will swim on 22,23,24,29 and 30 June as well as 1,6,7 and 8 July. We will be putting out a notice on School Stream very shortly asking for helpers for the juniors. There is a few things that you can do to help prepare your wee ones.

- 1. Ensure your child can dry and dress themselves.
- 2. Remind them what clothes they are wearing that day (particularly under garments).
- 3. Ensure your child can dry their hair, particularly if it is longer.
- 4. Name their towels togs and clothing
- 5. Make it easier by having easy clothes to take off and put on and shoes they can put on unaided.

Not too much really, but every bit helps to minimise the confusion that can reign in the changing rooms.

### **Donovan Primary Cross Country**





## Lost Property.


Don't forget to keep checking the lost property. The pile is getting quite large. Any items left at the end of term, will be donated to a worthy cause. They go on display every Friday.
