Kia Ora, Talofa lava, tena kotou katoa, warm greetings to you all.

This newsletter is our second last one for 2023. Hard to believe we are now in November and nearly half way through the term. Next week the first of the Y5/6 classes leave for Camp Omaui. Please check your equipment lists and cross those fingers for good weather.

- 17 November—Our Year 6 students have their New Entrant morning at their chosen High School. The information has been sent to you directly from your high school. Any enquiries please contact your respective school. We have a class at camp on this day, Room 20, so we have arranged a van to bring the children out to their visit and take them back to camp.
- 24 November—Most important to note is that Donovan Primary is closed for a nationwide Teacher Only day where all schools are closed around that date. Please make arrangements to have your children looked after and please notify any after school services you might belong to.
- 8 December—Look out for the End of Year school reports. If you have changed your email address let the office know ASAP (like now!) We have emailed reports for the past 2 years. If you have had issues getting them please check in with the office to update your email.
- 13 December is 'Year 6 Day Out'. Look out for notices for this event. (Lunch will be provided that day for the Year 6 leavers.) Year 6 Graduation will be held at Southland Boys High School on Herbert Street. Please be seated and ready to go by 6.30pm. Children are to be there by 6.15pm to be put in order of going on stage.
- 14 December—Merit Assemblies will be on this day. Juniors at 11am in the Donovan Primary Hall, Year 3/4/5/6 will be 1.30pm also in the Donovan Primary Hall.
- Friday 15 December is Prizegiving day, please note it takes place in the morning at 9.30am at Southland Boys High School. This is different from the afternoon slot we normally have. Children will be taken by bus to and from Southland Boys. School will finish at 1pm on this day when the flag goes down.
- Keep an eye on the important dates (on the left). We have posted next years dates as well for your records.

COMMUNICATION:

If you are collecting children early from school or they will be late due to appointments, sleeping in or any other reason, please advise the office. We are required to sign in late children and sign out children leaving school early. These students should come through the office and not wait out on the street or have parents come directly to the class. This is all put in place to ensure the safety of your children.

If you know you have an appointment coming up or your child/ren will be away, you can fill in a School Stream absence form anytime, or ring the office or send an email, with the relevant dates and we can hold it here for when that date rolls around. That way when life gets busy you are less likely to forget to notify us which will result in a phone call. If we cannot contact you regarding an absent child, we must by law, mark your child as Truant. Our attendance data is sent to Ministry of Education regularly and too many truancies, unexplained absences or unjustified absences could result in the Truancy Office becoming involved. Holidays during school time are not a justified absence. So please keep the office informed of any activity that is not the norm.

Scholastic Book Club

The final campaign for the year will be out shortly. We will send home the flyers when they arrive and orders will only be open for a week. We will let you know through School Stream.

We are looking at trying to minimise money at the school and encouraging all future orders to be completed online. If you order within the timeframe we set, the books will come to school as one order and we will distribute as normal. Any special instructions can be still done through the online system. If you should happen to miss our timeframe, you can still place an order but there will be a delivery charge as it will be delivered to your home.

We will still send home the flyers for you to look through and advise the closing date, and leave it up to you.

Medication

Just a reminder that if you are requiring your child to have any medication administered during school hours, there are a few things we need. (This includes inhalers)

- All medication must be handed into the office for safe keeping
- If it is a prescription medication, we do require it to be in a container showing the name and doseage on the script label.
- A medical consent form needs to be signed by the caregiver.

We do have a fridge in the medical room if medication needs to be kept cool. If your child has to take medication home each day, perhaps talk with the chemist and they may split the medicine into two containers, one for school and one for home. If medication does need to be taken home after school each day, it is the responsibility of the child to remember to come and collect it.

Helpful Tips for Minimizing Notifications on School Stream.

We understand that everyone is busy and reading the endless notifications we send out on School Stream can be time consuming. So if it would help, you can thin down the notifications you receive to ones that are relevant. Please read the link below.

Please keep the 'Whole School', 'Newsletters', 'Canteen', 'PTA', 'Community Notices', 'Covid' and relevant syndicate levels as essentials. (Sports folders and any others you select can be hidden). Do not panic, you can retrieve the folder again if your child decides to play sport, or change syndicate or has camp etc. I will post everything to the 'Whole School' folder if relevant for the whole school, but reminders etc will go to the respective folder. If you have not kept that folder, you will not see any notifications posted to it. Sports draws will go straight to the respective sports folder.

If you have not set up your account and try to start this process, School Stream will ask you to set this up first. Just follow the steps and once completed you will be able to hide folders. Have a look at the link and see if this would help.
