From the Principal's Desk

Kia Ora and Greetings

Welcome back to the 2025 school year. What a great start we have had with settled and 'pleased to be back' learners.

This year in NZ school is a big one in relation to implementing the New Curriculum. There is a new Maths and English Curriculum. Both of these curriculums require structured approaches. During the next two or so weeks we will be starting Y0-Y4 on 'Prime Maths Learning' and the staff will be working on learning the context and sequence and how to use the right workbooks with the right groups. English will have some changes which started last year with training in Structured Literacy approaches. The changes are going well as we try to embed these.

All NZ teachers from this year, require one day classroom release time per fortnight. To provide a seamless system for the children we have started two classroom release teaching spaces. These are staffed by Ms Gerken and Mrs Nally (with Ms Hughes doing 1 day per week). The programme being delivered this term is based around Science, PE skills and our Second Steps Programme. The children's own teacher meets them in the morning and takes them to classroom release teaching space one day per fortnights. The children will have the same teacher so we have minimal disruptions.

Important reminders that lateness to school is a form of truancy and will be monitored. The Government is placing greater importance this year on attendance at school. If your details have changed over the last few months eg, cellphone number; email address; postal address; custody arrangements, please contact the office as soon as possible to update your records.

As we start the new year, it's the right time to get the right routines in place; starting with drop offs and pick ups on Drury Lane. Please do not walk your children across Drury Lane unless it is on the Road Patrol Crossing, we need to all model this for our children.

We hope you have had a great start to the year and we look forward to a year full of new learning and developing Resilient, Empathetic, Adaptable, Lifelong Learners.

Canteen Heatups.

Just a reminder that it costs 20c per heatup per student to have your child's lunch nice and hot for lunchtime.

The PTA have tried to make it as easy as possible by charging 20c per heatup or \$4 per term or \$10 per year per child.

You can send the money along to either the office or the canteen anytime or pay for it with the Friday Menu through School Stream.

The heatup service may become unavailable to families who make no effort to pay for this service. The canteen would like arrears to be settled as soon as possible please. A note will come home as a reminder. The easiest way is to pay for a year subs of \$10 per child for the entire year and you don't have to hunt out 20c every time you wish to have a nice warm lunch for your child/ren.

Medication

Just a reminder that if you are requiring your child to have any medication administered during school hours, there are a few things we need. (This includes inhalers)

- All medication must be handed into the office for safe keeping
- If it is a prescription medication, we do require it to be in a container showing the name and doseage on the script label.
- A medical consent form needs to be signed by the caregiver.

We do have a fridge in the medical room if medication needs to be kept cool. If your child has to take medication home each day, perhaps talk with the chemist and they may split the medicine into two containers, one for school and one for home. If medication does need to be taken home after school each day, it is the responsibility of the child to remember to come and collect it.

Helpful Tips for Minimizing Notifications on School Stream.

We understand that everyone is busy and reading the endless notifications we send out on School Stream can be time consuming. So if it would help, you can thin down the notifications you receive to ones that are relevant. Please read the link below.

Please keep the 'Whole School', 'Newsletters', 'Canteen', 'PTA', 'Community Notices', 'Covid' and relevant syndicate levels as essentials. (Sports folders and any others you select can be hidden). Do not panic, you can retrieve the folder again if your child decides to play sport, or change syndicate or has camp etc. I will post everything to the 'Whole School' folder if relevant for the whole school, but reminders etc will go to the respective folder. If you have not kept that folder, you will not see any notifications posted to it. Sports draws will go straight to the respective sports folder.

If you have not set up your account and try to start this process, School Stream will ask you to set this up first. Just follow the steps and once completed you will be able to hide folders. Have a look at the link and see if this would help.
