Absences

Please remember to contact the office via School Stream, phone, text or email to advise of any students absence or lateness. The Ministry of Education is still encouraging schools to follow up more vigorously for non attendance. If we have no contact we will mark your child as Truant. Holidays during term time are not accepted and your child will be marked with an unjustified absence.

Remember to keep an eye on School Stream as we have a lot going on this term, and School Stream is how we will keep you informed.

Outstanding Fees: -

Don't forget to pay for your child's sports fees or your senior students camp fee. We don't enjoy chasing up money that is owed, and you committed to paying when signing up for a sporting code.

Mobile Dental Bus

The mobile dental bus is currently at school and will probably be here for most of the year. They will work their way through seeing all the children at Donovan Primary and preschool siblings. If you have any concerns or need to see them earlier you can contact them on 0272849937. If they don't answer, then please leave a message and they will call you back once they have no patients.

We have communicated many times about the major priority of the Government around attendance and being at school on time. This year NZ schools are implementing new procedures, these are to be in place by Term 1 2026. The Government target is for 80% of students to attend regularly, that is to attend school more than 90% of the time.

Good Attendance (Good chance of success)—is less than 5 days absence in a school term.

Worrying Attendance (Less chance of success) is up to 10 days absence in a school term.

Concerning Attendance (Hard to make progress) is up to 15 days absence in a school term.

Serious Concern (Very hard to make progress) is 15 days or more of absence in a school term.

We will communicate with you if your child is at any of the above stages and we will endeavour to work with you to achieve good attendance.

Lateness is electronically recorded and monitored. Of all absence problems, this is by far our biggest concern. Having learners at school, <u>in class by 8.50am</u> is what we need to achieve., A reminder—children are <u>NOT</u> to be dropped off before 8.20am. There is no supervision of care until 8.20am.
